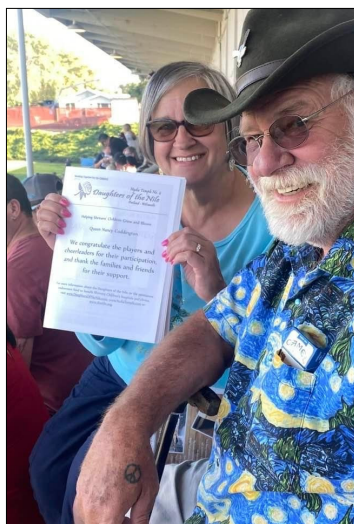
Will you be the Big Winner of the Gift Card Tree?

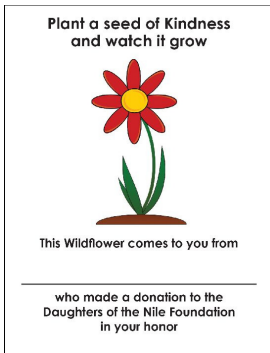

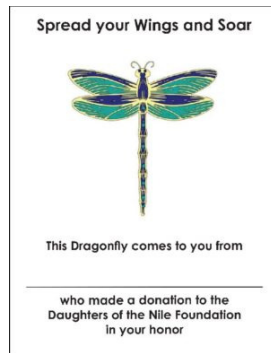
