# OASIS LogIn How-to

The correct Website for Nydia Temple #4 is <https://nydiatemple.org>  
The URL for Supreme is <https://daughtersofthenile.org/>  
To login to OASIS, you must have a login to **Supreme Daughters of the Nile website**. If you don't already have one, you will need to register:

## **To Register for Supreme Daughters of the Nile:**

Go to the Supreme DON Website listed above.

Click on *Create your Account* on the DON home page. This will open a new page, fill in the requested information. For the Invitation Code, use **Nyd-Ftihq** The system will require a "STRONG PASSWORD", so use numbers, capital letters and symbols. Once you have completed all the required fields, click *Create your Account*. This will verify you are a daughter of the Nile, and let you proceed further.

Once you verify your account for DON, you will need to create a user id and password for OASIS. Use an email address and a STRONG password. (A strong password contains, Upper & Lower case letters, Numbers and Special Characters).

## ***To get started on OASIS:***

From the Home page of DON, Click OASIS Login link. At the OASIS Login page, click on the registration link in the upper right part of the page.

At that page, you will need to input:

***Temple: #4***

***Oasis ID:*** Contact anyone who has access to Oasis, Nydia Banker, or Recorder to get your number.

***Last Name:***

Then click check membership status. Once the system verifies your status as a member of DON, the System will ask for your email address to create your user id and for you to create your password.

You can use the same User id and password for both DON login and OASIS login.

Login to Oasis and see all the features available.



# Dreamgirls' Rose Garden

Last year the Temple Queens, the Dreamgirls, were looking for an idea for a gift to give our Supreme Queen Kathy. The usual ideas were presented - a quilt, a donation with a plaque, or a contribution to her travel fund. When Kathy was asked about what she would really like, her response was that she would like something done for the Hospital, the **Portland** Hospital. A suggestion was made by Judy Woodrow of Omar Temple in Ontario, Canada, of a healing garden. Since Kathy is such a fan of roses, and since Portland *is* the City of Roses, that healing garden took another turn, turning into the concept of a rose garden.

I took the idea to the hospital administrator, Dereesa Reid, who thought we could make it work. It turns out that Dereesa is also a lover of roses and has a large rose garden of her own. Then the concept was taken to the Dreamgirls who also were onboard with the idea.

So, after a lot of planning and cooperation from the hospital personnel, the idea came to fruition on February 20. The 25 rosebushes are various shades of pink, combined with white bushes, and sprinkled with blasts of color. A bronze plaque distinguishes the garden as being donated for Kathy from the Dreamgirls. Funded by the hospital is a large park bench that visitors to the garden can enjoy while viewing the garden.

Dedication of the rose garden on February 20 was part of the Homecoming celebration. Members from many of our temples, including a total of 12 temple Queens, were in attendance. We were honored to have an honor guard from the Royal Rosarians (City of Portland Ambassadors), and a beautiful message from their Prime Minister, Ron Fisher. Since

The dedication was filmed by a local news station, and our Supreme Queen Kathy was interviewed. The first viewing was the 5 o'clock news and expanded with each time it aired. By the time I watched on the 11 o'clock news, not only did they show Kathy and the Royal Rosarians, and me standing at the podium, but it also gave the purpose of Daughters of the Nile and how we support the hospitals. They talked about the amount of money to date that the American Foundation has presented to the hospitals.

All in all, it was a spectacular day. We didn't get rained on, and everyone's spirits were over the moon.

## Hospital Program:

Hospital Administration, Pr. Dereesa Reid's goal is for a 20% patient growth for 2026, and now Portland is considered a regional hospital with the addition of the Vancouver Clinic.

We had representatives from the Gait and Motion Lab, Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services (POPS), and Pediatric Rehab Services giving the audience a highlight of each department.
